



ANTI RAGGING POLICY

The Unnamalai Institute of Technology severely prohibits ragging. Any behaviour, whether through spoken or written words or actions, that leads to harassing, teasing, treating or handling rudely any other student, participating in rowdyism or rough activities that cause or are likely to cause aggravation, difficulties, or emotional damage, or that stimulate fear or apprehension of such harm in a new or junior student, or asking students to perform an act that they would not typically do and that is out of the ordinary.

It is forbidden to engage in behaviour that intentionally targets other students (freshmen or not) and is physical or mental in nature, such as bullying and exclusion, on the basis of one's gender (including transgender identity), sexual orientation, physical appearance, citizenship, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of where they live, or socioeconomic status.

The following acts are followed in Anti Ragging Cell:

- To ban, prevent, and completely eradicate the scourge of ragging, which includes any student behaviour that has the effect of teasing, treating (pay the bill) another student especially a fresher or engaging in loud or unruly behaviour.
- To supervise, lead, and control the Anti-Ragging Squads' performance in preventing and reducing ragging inside the institution.

Ragging Committee Cell includes following Responsibilities:

- ✓ The committee members should promote knowledge among new commers.
- ✓ Seminars should be conducted to educate the senior students on the negative impacts of ragging and the associated punishments.
- ✓ The posting of anti-ragging signs throughout the campus.
- ✓ To carry out unexpected raids in hostels and other locations.
- ✓ To investigate any ragging incidents that are reported by a faculty member, student, parent, guardian.
- ✓ The investigation report and any recommendations will then be forwarded to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.
- ✓ At the institutional level, responsibility is essential. The faculty, administrative, and non-teaching personnel, as well as the particular body established to investigate ragging instances, must collaborate with a sense of moral propriety and bear responsibility for their actions.

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

1. Introduction

Unnamalai Institute of Technology is unequivocal in its stance against ragging. The institution strictly prohibits any form of behavior, whether verbal or physical, that may lead to harassment, teasing, mistreatment, or any activities causing emotional or physical harm to fellow students. This policy is aimed at fostering a safe and inclusive environment for all members of the academic community.

2. Definition and Prohibition of Ragging

2.1 Definition

Ragging encompasses any behavior, spoken or written, that involves harassing, teasing, treating rudely, engaging in rowdyism, or coercing students into performing acts that are outside the norm. It includes actions that create fear, apprehension, or emotional distress in new or junior students.

2.2 Prohibition

Engaging in behavior that intentionally targets other students based on factors such as gender, sexual orientation, physical appearance, citizenship, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence, or socioeconomic status is strictly forbidden. This includes both physical and mental forms of bullying and exclusion.

3. Acts Followed in Anti-Ragging Cell

3.1 Prevention and Eradication of Ragging

The Anti-Ragging Cell is dedicated to banning, preventing, and completely eradicating the scourge of ragging within the institution. This includes addressing any student behavior that involves teasing, treating, or engaging in unruly activities, especially targeting freshmen.
